We do use third-party financial institutions to process our donations. They receive the card number and other personal information only to verify and process transactions securely. We do not allow for any third parties to sell, trade or rent this data or use it for anything other than what they are contracted to do, or store the data over a long-term period.

Where you contribute material to us, e.g. user-generated content, we will generally only keep your content for as long as is reasonably required for the purpose(s) for which it was submitted, unless otherwise stated at the point of generation.

Legitimate interest

In some instances, we collect and use your personal information by relying on the legitimate interest legal basis. This includes and is not limited to:

- If you are or have been a staff member, volunteer or trustee of ITSA in the last 5 years.
